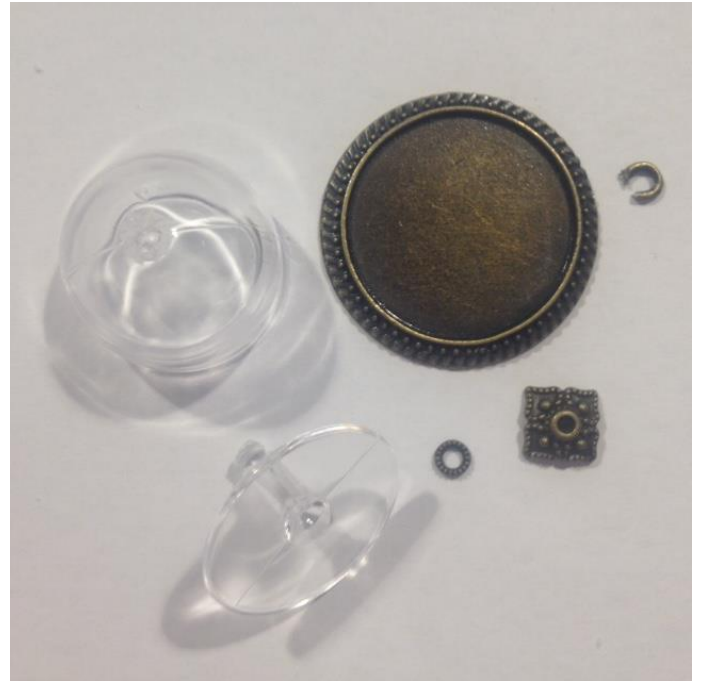


How to make the Christmas bell kit

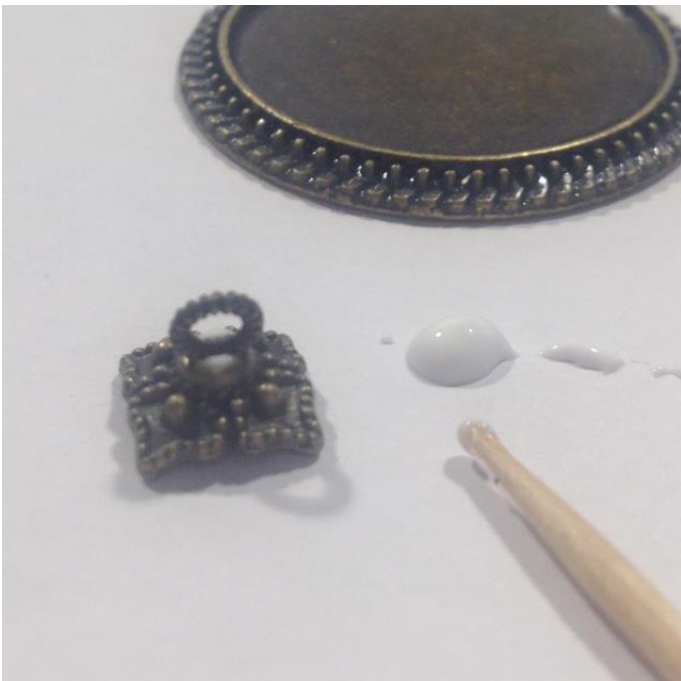

Remove carefully the "stand" of the bell with a knife or a saw.



These are the parts needed. Here the eye of the base and the stand of the bell are removed. These parts will not be used.



Glue the tiny ring to the top part with tacky glue or another type of glue that works on metal. Leave to dry!



If you want the metal parts painted, do this now. I use acrylic paint and just dab the paint on very easy, as I want the gold color to shine through.



Cut to pieces of the lycopodium for the tree. One side of it is more flat, now glue the two back sides together and try to make it look like one piece at the top.



If needed trim carefully your tree with a scissor to look more authentic.



Cover the midsection of the base with glue and apply a thin layer of snow. Glue the reindeers and tree to the base. Note that it is possible to put over the bell without breaking the antlers or the tree. Attach the bell with glue and finally glue on the top part. Leave it to dry before arranging it in your miniature scene,
